Rotary Clubs Donate \$521,000

The 12 Townsville Rotary Clubs made donations and funding contributions to the community of \$521,000 during the year ended 30 June 2017 with 74.5% being contributed to Townsville community. The biggest fund raiser was Townsville Sunrise Rotary Club with \$172,00 followed by Thuringowa Central Rotary Club \$71,000 and Mundingburra Rotary Club \$64,000.

Of the total funds raised by Rotary Clubs just over 50% (\$265,000) came from Rotary volunteers working at the four Rotary markets during the year. The Rotary Clubs make an outstanding contribution to the community.
